



## A. Natural minor


Construct the requested scale on the musical staff. All scales should be the "natural minor" version. Apply accidentals directly to the notes.




## B. "Harmonic" minor scales

Create the requested scale on the staff. Apply accidentals directly to the notes. All scales should be in the "harmonic" minor variant, with a raised leading tone. If your raised leading tone has no sharp on it, you can mark it with a natural to indicate that it has been altered.
